## CODE OF CONDUCT

Avonworth Community Pool opens Memorial Day weekend and closes its doors for the season Labor Day weekend.

The Pool is open Tuesday - Thursday, Friday & Sunday 12 - 6. Wednesdays & Saturdays 12-7. Passholders gain early access at 11 a.m. Closed on Mondays for private parties.

Those who attend Avonworth Community Pool and Passholders are required to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Membership cards must be scanned upon entry.
- Children under the age of 12, must be accompanied by an adult. Any children found at the pool not accompanied by an adult are at risk of losing their pool pass or general admission
- Management and the Pool Board reserve the right to close the pool under these circumstances:
  - The weather is unsuitable for swimming
  - Thunder delays persist and become hazardous to staff and patrons
  - The pool suffers from damage from a storm
  - There is an unforeseen emergency
  - Sparse attendance
  - Management believes that the pool is unsafe at anytime
- Patrons should not come to the pool if they are feeling unwell
- Smoking, alcohol consumption and possession, drug use, or spitting are prohibited within the facility. Smoking is permitted in the designated areas outside of the front gate
- Patrons should not come to the pool if they are under the influence of any substance that might hamper their ability to be safe in the water
- It is the responsibility of the patron to notify a lifeguard or manager if they are experiencing any issues
- Management may revoke the use of recreation equipment provided by the pool: cornhole, ping pong etc. for misuse and or damage
- The manager on duty reserves the right to remove pool patrons who are not following the posted rules: acting in an unsafe manner, disrespecting both staff or fellow patrons, and acting in an overall disruptive manner. This removal may be for the remainder of the day, possibly the remainder of the season
- Tables in the snack bar area may not be reserved and are not for storing belongings. Unattended belongings left in the snack bar may be removed by the management

### General Pool/Swimming Rules:

- No diving in shallow water. See sidewalk markings if unsure
- No prolonged underwater swimming or breath holding
- Only US Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted in the Main Pool. Rafts and pool floats are permitted in the main pool at the discretion of the pool management and based on the number of swimmers in the pool. Age appropriate flotation devices and water wings are permitted in the Wading Pool. No flotation devices are allowed on the slide, in the deep end or off of the diving board.
- Appropriate swim attire is required
- Changing of diapers is permitted in the Locker Room area only
- All animals, with the exception of service animals, are prohibited from entering the Pool Area, with the exception of our annual dog swim
- Absolutely no running, excessive splashing, or horseplay on the pool deck and diving board.
- Balls and toys are permitted in both the wading pool and the main pool at the discretion of the staff and allowed usage may be based on the number of guests in the pool
